## **Tiebreak**

### **a) Direct encounters**

Results of direct encounters between the tied players (If all the tied players have met each other, the sum of points from these encounters is used. The player with the highest score is ranked number 1 and so on. If some but not all have played each other, the player with a score that could not be equalled by any other player (if all such games had been played) is ranked number 1 and so on,

b) Buchholz Cut 1

c) Buchholz

d) The greater number of games played with black,

e) The Greater number of wins.

## **System of play – Round Robin G17 and O17**

a) Direct encounters

## **Rate of play**

The playing session in each round shall be about 5 hours, with time-control at 90 minutes for 40 moves followed 30 minutes for remaining moves and 30 seconds per move from the beginning of the game or from the 1st move.

**Play according to the FIDE Laws of Chess valid from January 1, 2018.**

**Default time is 15 minutes for each round.**
